Rules and Regulations

1. Students must arrive at school 5 minutes before the school starts.
2. Students coming not in School Uniform will be sent back from the school.
3. Silence in the classroom is mandatory. While changing the class room, special care should be taken for the other classes in progress.
4. No student is allowed to go outside the school premises or home excepted the method adopted by the school or by the parents.
5. Inside the school premises the students are not allowed to ride cycles.
6. The Students should take care of their books and the school property. Anything damaged, destroyed, should be reported at once to the Pi rteiple.
7. It is not advisable to bring valuable articles in the school. Books Bags, Pencils, Tiffin-carrier, should be marked with student's name.
8. Where there is a out brake of any contagious disease in the family, student shall not come to school without the usual certificates from the doctor.
9. If a boy has been absent, the reason for his absence should be explained by the parents/guardians in the assignment book.
10. No leave of absence is granted except prior written application from the parents/guardians excepting sickness.
11. Books, other than course books, magazine and news papers shall not be brought in the school without the Principal's concent.
12. Co-operation for the well being of the child even in the form of complain is highly appreciated. But parents/Guardians are requested to sent the same in writing.
13. When the school is in moiion, the parents should not visit the class. The time will be fixed by the Principal for any appointment with any teacher.
14. Deficiency of student's is discussed in the parents teachers association meeting. The date and time of the meeting is communicated to the parent's/guardians by the Principal.



Guidelines For The Parents

1. Check up this diary daily at your home, when the child comes back and read the instructions given by her class teacher.
2. Help the child in her home work.
3. If any thing is missing then inform the school the very next day.
4. If the student is ill then inform the school or send an application.
5. You are requested not to talk to any of the teachers during their study period. Only see the principal / headmistress in the office, when you visit the school.
6. If the teacher finds the doubtful character of the student then he will also be out of school, immediately after warnings.
7. Your child will not be send from her class to her home study period unless you give a written application to her teacher.
